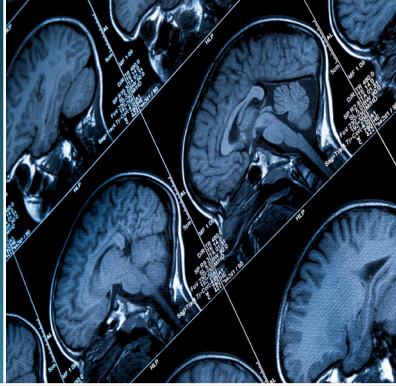

Diagnostic Services

Our team provides complete diagnostic services to establish seizure classification, assess response to medical therapy and evaluate patients for epilepsy surgery, including:

- EEG
- Video-EEG Monitoring Unit
- Intracranial EEG
- Electrocorticography and Cortical Stimulation
- Brain Imaging Technology
- MRI and MRS
- Functional MRI
- Diffusion Tensor Imaging and Fiber Tracking
- PET
- SPECT
- Wada Test
